Resolution Supporting the Green Amendment

Whereas, the Appalachian Mountain Club is concerned about the health and welfare of the citizens of New Jersey and the environment in which they live.

Whereas, the Appalachian Mountain Club supports securing a constitutional right to pure water and soil, clean air, a stable climate, and healthy environments, for all people, including future generations, regardless of race, socioeconomics, or ethnicity.

Whereas, the Appalachian Mountain Club recognizes that the “Green Amendments” in Pennsylvania, New York, and Montana, which elevate the right to a clean, unpolluted environment to the level of other constitutionally guaranteed rights, have been successful in protecting the health and welfare of the citizens from adverse effects of environmental degradation and pollution, therefore be it

Resolved, the Appalachian Mountain Club supports passage of the State of New Jersey Green Amendment (SCR43 and ACR119), which would amend the New Jersey’s constitution to provide that every person in the State of New Jersey has a constitutional right to clean air, pure water, and a healthy environment.

Adopted by the Appalachian Mountain Club on November 4, 2025.
