RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE NEW JERSEY GREEN AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, Township of Haddon is concerned about the health and welfare of the citizens of New Jersey and the environment in which they live; and

WHEREAS, Township of Haddon supports securing a constitutional right to pure water and soil, clean air, a stable climate and healthy environments, for all people, including future generations, regardless of race, socioeconomic status or ethnicity; and

WHEREAS, Township of Haddon recognizes that the "Green Amendments" in Pennsylvania, New York and Montana which elevate the right to a clean and unpolluted environment to the level of other constitutionally guaranteed rights, have been successful in protecting the health and welfare of the citizens from adverse effects of environmental degradation and pollution;

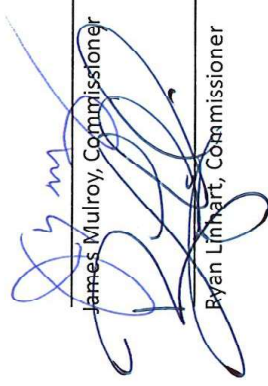
THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Haddon, County of Camden, and State of New Jersey support passage of the State of New Jersey Green Amendment (SCR43 and ACR119), which would allow voters the opportunity to choose whether to add the right to clean air, pure water, and a healthy environment to the Bill of Rights of the New Jersey State Constitution.

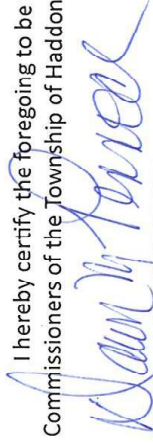
